





KIT INCLUDES:

- 1 x SLRV XSPEC 'XFRAME'
- 2 x Tie down bar brackets
- 2 x Tied down bar protection sleeves
- 2 x Utility Rail fittings
- 4 x M6 x 16 SS hex screws with washers

TOOLS REQUIRED:

- M5 allen key (supplied)
- M10 Spanner / Socket
- NOTE: Accessories can be pre mounted to the XFRAME before fitment to the vehicle OR fitted afterwards by leaving the utility rail fittings off and rotating the XFRAME upwards to secure hardware. Utility rail fittings should then be fitted and all mounts tightened as per instructions.





 Note: If a Rhino factory roofrack is fitted, slide the unit back so it is flush with the rear of the Grenadier as pictured.



Place tie down bar protection sleeves on bar as pictured





*Medium Loctite should be used on all threads. Tighten down screws evenly on both sides of each bracket until snug. Brackets should still be able to rotate and slide along the bar. Brackets should be at 45 degree angle approx. as pictured.






Hold XFRAME in position (if fitting with accessories already attached you
will require assistance), adjust or rotate mounting brackets as necessary to
align with holes and insert 4 off M6 x 16 hex screws with flat and spring
washers as pictured. Hand tighten these 4 screws.





Slide the XFRAME and brackets left or right to align with the edge of the
rear window. Ensure protective sleeves remain in place under the
mounting brackets. Once the XFRAME is aligned with the window, remove
the top 4 bolts and tighten down the tie down bar brackets on the rail. Re
fit the XFRAME and tighten the 4 bolts. XFRAME will still be able to rotate
vertically about the tie down bar brackets.





 Position the two utility rail fittings in the rail so they align with the centre, holes on the bottom of the XFRAME. *Take care - Bolt heads should be locked in place behind the rail so they cant come out. A piece of electrical tape can be used top and bottom to hold the fitting in place while fitting.







Lower XFRAME (making sure Utility Rail fittings stay in place)





Fit flat washer and nylock nut to utility rail fittings.





- Tighten top and bottom hardware until snug. *Do not overtighten. Your
 XFRAME is ready to go.
- XFRAME's are limited to 40kg capacity per side.
